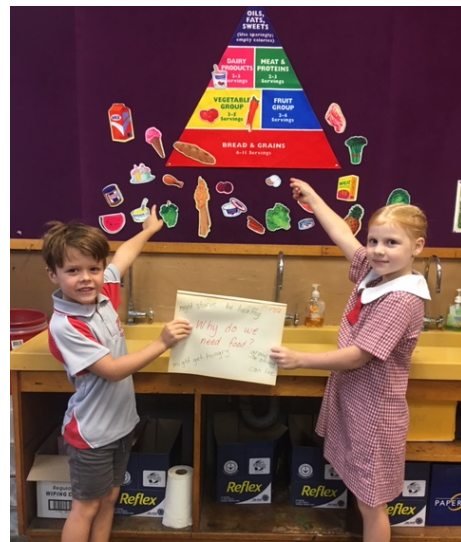
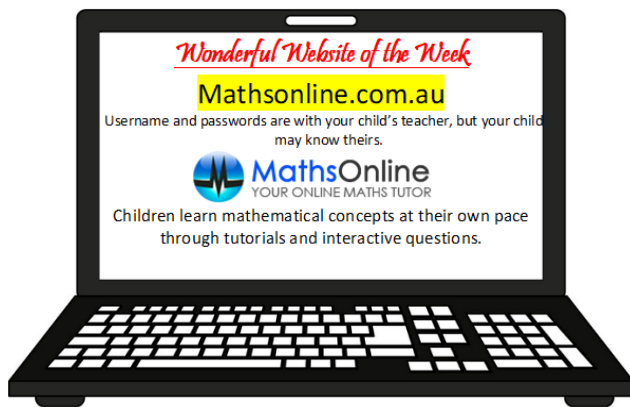
Please remember not to bring food with nuts as we have several Kindergarten students who are highly allergic to them.
